



Brooklyn Queens Aquifer Study

Konheim and Ketcham conducted extensive statistical and graphical documentation of land uses surrounding over 70 proposed well sites in Brooklyn and Queens. Potential cultural resources at each well site location were identified, many of which were on park land and open space. Sensitive receptors to noise and air, as defined under CEQR guidelines, were also identified. Review of New York City Zoning Resolution was conducted to determine proposed well site compliance with zoning regulation. The work that was conducted in this study lays the groundwork for future environmental assessment.
